Vaccinations

We offer 3 vaccines for cats. (Please indicate which vaccines you are interested in.)

***When starting this vaccine for the first time or if overdue, your cat may need a booster in 3 weeks.**

___ **FVRCP**- This core vaccination helps protect your cat against upper respiratory disease.*

___ **Rabies (PureVax) 1 year**- ___ **Rabies (Purevax) 3 year** (has an additional cost \$76). This core vaccine for rabies virus is required by Washington state rule, WAC 246-100-197.

___ **FELV**- This vaccination for leukemia virus is recommended for cats that go outdoors, commingle with other cats, go to shows, or are in environments with many cats. Your cat should test negative for FELV before starting this vaccine series.*

Parasite Prevention

The Companion Animal Parasite Council recommends:

- √ fecal test every 6 months
 - √ year-round flea & tick control & heartworm prevention
 - √ regular broad spectrum deworming
 - **Activity against tapeworms for cats that hunt.**

Laboratory Screening

We believe that we can keep pets healthy longer by diagnosing chronic illnesses early. Our veterinarians have specifically selected laboratory panels for our patients to gather optimal information at our yearly appointments. We want to look at specific lab values depending on: chronic illnesses, medication usage, and lifestage. If you are unsure of which lab package you might choose for your pet, your doctor will assist you.*

*Please note that the prices listed do include a venipuncture fee for blood draws and a cystocentesis fee for urine samples. If we need to add on extra testing, we will contact you. Please allow 3-5 business days for results.

FELV/FIV Test (\$47.12)

*This is the in-house blood test that screens for leukemia and “feline aids”. We perform this test on kittens, cats who are being newly introduced into the home, and pets who are starting the FELV vaccination.

Pre-operative panel (\$86.30)

*If you are scheduling a dentistry or an anesthetic procedure, this is a good choice. We recommend adding on a fecal and a heartworm antibody test.

Senior Panel 1: Complete Blood Count, Chemistry, Kidney Disease and Diabetes Test, Thyroid Test, Urinalysis (\$181.40)

*Your feline friend doesn’t have to be a senior to run this panel! This is an excellent panel to learn a ton about your pet. The doctors call it a “minimum database” and it will be a comprehensive screening of your cat’s health. This panel is **highly recommended for cats age 6 and older** to help us identify health concerns early.

Fecal parasite check with Giardia Elisa (\$67.65)

*The Companion Animal Parasite Control and Soundview Veterinary Hospital recommends fecal testing at least twice per year. This is especially true for pets who go outside and attend boarding & grooming.

Heartworm antibody test (\$45.32)

*The American Heartworm Society recommends yearly heartworm testing. At Soundview Veterinary Hospital we believe that dogs AND cats should be screened for heartworm disease. For this reason, we offer antibody testing, the gold standard for screening feline patients.
