Vaccinations

We offer 5 vaccines for dogs. The protocol is determined by you and your veterinarian based on the lifestyle of your dog. (Please indicate which vaccines you are interested in.)

SVH does not carry the lyme and rattlesnake vaccinations.

*When starting this series for the first time or if your pet is overdue, a 3 week booster may be recommended.

___ **DAP**- This is a core vaccine for distemper & parvovirus.*

___ **Rabies**- This core vaccine for rabies virus is required by Washington state rule, WAC 246-100-197.

___ **Leptospirosis**- This vaccination is for a zoonotic bacteria that is transmitted through the urine of wildlife. Since we now have racoons and other wildlife freely living in housing developments, housepets are more likely to be exposed.*

___ **Bordetella**- This is the "kennel cough" vaccination. It helps protect against a common cause of "cold" in dogs. It is required by most boarding facilities and is recommended for dogs that interact with other dogs.*

___ **Influenza**- This vaccine is given based on lifestyle and if there are any current outbreaks of flu. It is recommended for dogs who attend dog shows, travel or are frequently boarding. Some local boarding facilities require this vaccine.*

Parasite Prevention

The Companion Animal Parasite Council recommends:
√ annual heartworm test
√ fecal test every 6 months
√ year-round flea & tick control & heartworm prevention
√ monthly intestinal parasite control

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Laboratory Screening

We believe that we can keep pets healthy longer by diagnosing chronic illnesses early. Our veterinarians have specifically selected screening laboratory panels for our patients to gather optimal information at our yearly appointments. We want to look at specific lab values depending on: breed predispositions, chronic illnesses, medication usage, and lifestage. If you are unsure of which lab package you might choose for your pet, your doctor will assist you.

*Please note that the prices listed do include a venipuncture fee for blood draws and a cystocentesis fee for urine samples. If we need to add on extra testing, we will contact you. Please allow 3-5 business days for results.

Pre-operative panel (\$86.30)

*If you are scheduling a dentistry or anesthetic procedure, this is a good choice. We recommend adding on a fecal parasite check and a heartworm test as additional tests.

Senior Panel 1: Complete Blood Count, Chemistry, Thyroid Test, Urinalysis (\$181.40)

*Your dog doesn't have to be a senior to run this panel! This is an excellent panel to learn a ton about your pet. The doctors call it a "minimum database" and it will be a comprehensive screening of your canine companion's health.

Fecal parasite check with a Giardia Elisa (\$67.65)

*The Companion Animal Parasite Control and Soundview Veterinary Hospital recommends fecal testing at least twice per year. This is especially true for pets who attend doggy daycare, boarding and grooming.

Canine Heartworm Test (\$45.32)

*The American Heartworm Society and Soundview Veterinary Hospital recommend yearly heartworm testing.
